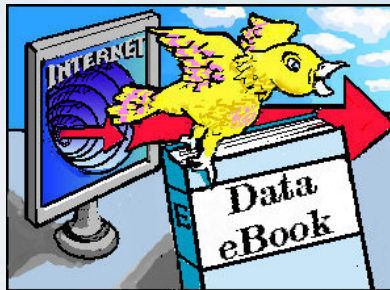
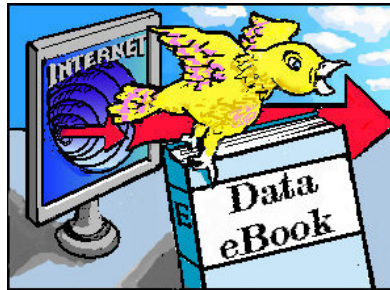

## **eBook Overview**

The Demographic eBook has been designed to provide both a quick reference guide to our most commonly requested variables as well as providing printable reports for areas of interest the user.

Some users will find the font size quite small, and this design choice was driven by our desire to give you printed reports with the most possible data per page. To this end, you will find some reports designed in Portrait mode and longer reports designed in Landscape mode.

## **Report Layouts**

The Demographic eBook is organized by Geography (i.e. State Reports, or County Report), States within Geography, and the Reports with State.

## **Viewing Reports**

The Demographic eBook will be most easily read when you select Single Pane from the View->Page Layout menu. You might want to select View and Zoom to increase the level of your reading comfort.

## **Printing Reports**

Each report is numbered individually (beginning with page 1) to provide you with the most professional looking print output possible. However when printing you must take care to select only the Current Page, or the range of pages (found at the bar of your Reader) that correspond to the eBook Report you want to print.

## EASI Definitions

### Data Overview

Most of the Data Elements in the EASI Demographic eBook speak for themselves. Unless otherwise noted, these are estimates as of 1/1/2009.

There are however, several variables which, over time, have generated more questions for us than most, so we will provide a brief discussion of those below.

### Total Population and Race

Total Population is defined as the sum of the 4 racial population groups:

- White Alone
- Black Alone
- Asian and Pacific Islander
- Other

Hispanics are considered, by the Census Bureau, as an Ethnic group, not a Racial group and is presented separately with White Non-Hispanic. Hispanic can represent White Hispanic, Black Hispanic, Asian Hispanic, or Other Hispanic. The census designation is a result of respondee self reporting.

### Average Household Size

You may notice that the Average Household Size value does not exactly equal Population divided by Households as you might expect. This is because the actual computation for this variable is Population - Group Quarters Population divided by Households.

### EASI Quality of Life Index

EASI has developed one measure to represent an overall "quality of life" measure (EASI Quality of Life). We have included the following factors:

### EASI Weather Index

Everyone talks about the weather but EASI products quantify it. These data are obtained from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), the National Environmental Satellite Data, the Information Service and the National Climatic Data Center. These data represent a variety of readings of local climatological data. EASI products use normals and means for the measures of weather based on a 30 year base (1961 to 1990).

Defining the weather is a very unusual task. "Good" or "bad" weather is not strictly definable. Although rain is not considered good by many, areas that have no rain are deserts. In addition, people's preferences for weather vary substantially. Some people like it hot, some hate the cold, etc. Therefore, EASI has developed some rules to quantify weather. In EASI products, we have made a few assumptions about the weather based on the following variables:

Mean Number of Days of Snow	-1
Average Annual Precipitation	-1
Average Annual Snowfall	-1
Annual Maximum Average Temperature	1

Notes: • Since weather variables are not available by ZIP Code or for most counties, EASI assigned the readings to the closest weather station.

### EASI Crime Index

Total Crime data are based on the latest reported crimes information provided by the Federal Bureau of

Investigation (FBI). EASI has used the reported data as our starting point to develop a model that is used to estimate Total Crime for all levels of geography.
